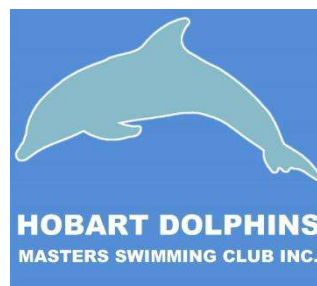

I won't ramble on any more, because in this case, a picture says a thousand words.



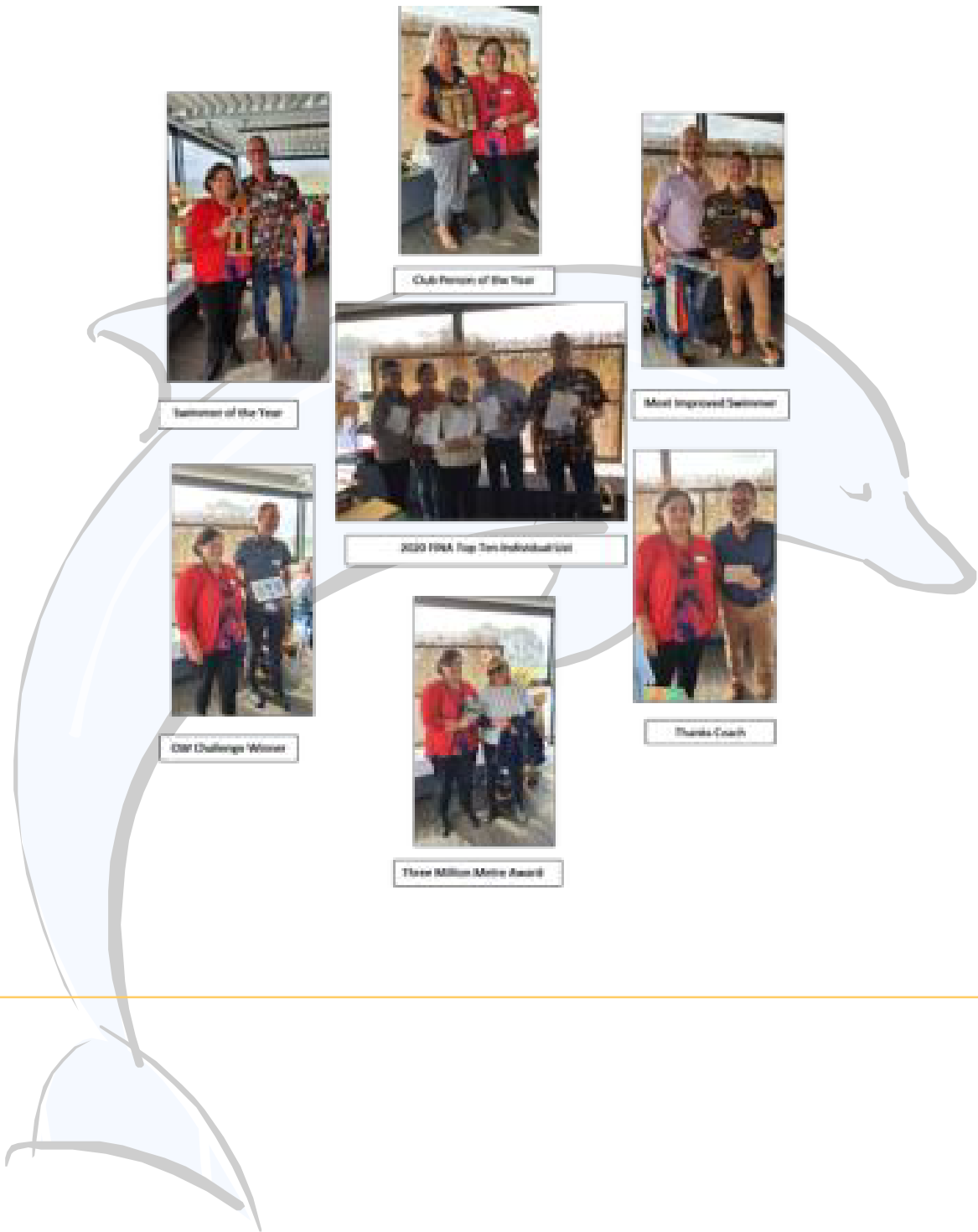

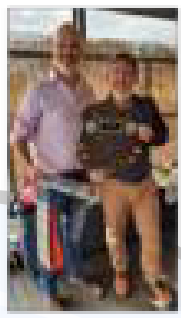

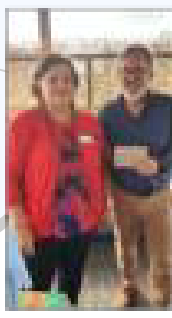
