## WORLD MASTERS SWIMMING SHEFFIELD UK

Ponds Forge swimming centre is a huge complex. The main 50m pool has 10 lanes and can be converted to 3 x 25m pools sideways, a diving pool, 25m warm up pool, water slides and a "Tidal River" - swimmers train by swimming against the "tide". This tide can be fixed so that you have to do a world record just to stand still!!! The meet incorporated swimming, diving, synchronised swimming, open water swimming and water polo. There were 4,500 entries from 46 different countries. Three Hobart Master's members were among the entrants taking part. Ages ranged from 25 to 95. Coach Peter Fisher had up to 79 heats in his back stroke events, with approximately 150 men in his age group. Despite the huge numbers the meet was run without a hitch by local swim clubs and voluntary workers. Congratulations to Peter for his several PBs. Diver Ernie Webster performed with his usual skill, receiving 2 silver medals in the 3 and 1 meter boards and a bronze on the platform. There were 75 ladies in Justine Bamford's age group, including 5 current world record holders. Justine received 1 bronze and 2 fifth placings. Well done all three. This club is proud of you.

### WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS
